Limited to two entries per person.

Rules and Information:

Plein Air Painting is painting done outdoors. Painters work by natural light and are influenced by atmospheric conditions of weather and culture. This approach was made famous by the 19th century Barbizon School in France and perfected in the 20th century by the Taos Society of Artists in New Mexico.

Rules:

1. Adults 18 and over, amateur or professional. Preregistration required.
2. Bring in your own art supplies and be ready to paint on location, within the Fairgrounds. No matting or framing of art is allowed. Maximum size 16" x 20". Only artwork created on the Fairgrounds during the Fair will be eligible for competition. Artist's choice of medium (acrylic, oils, pastels, water color, etc.)
3. Dates May 29 and May 30. Artist may enter both days, however a single painting must be started and completed during 1 day.
4. Check in at Building C Stage after 9:00am on the day you plan to paint. All exhibitors must pick up their exhibitor tag when they check in. Your canvas must be stamped by Fair staff prior to beginning your work. After completion of your art, deliver it to the stage area in Building

C for display and judging. Art must be affixed to a firm support board and displayed on your own easel. All artwork will be on display for the remainder of the Fair. Exhibits will be released on Monday, May 31, between 7:00 and 9:00 p.m.

5. Awards presentation will be at 4:00 p.m. on Monday, May 31, at the exhibit hall stage.
