1. With interactive judging each exhibitor will be asked to bring his or her exhibits to the Fair and they will be judged at the time of delivery. This is a perfect opportunity for the exhibitors to receive comments from the judge and find out how the exhibit places before the fair opens.
2. If you would like to participate in Interactive Judging but this schedule does not work for you, please call us at (916) 263-2975 and we will be happy to reschedule you.
3. If you are unable to participate in Interactive Judging, you or someone you know can deliver your exhibits to the Fair on Friday, May 21, between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. or on Saturday, May 22, between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 Noon. Teachers who are delivering student work may do so at this time, however teachers are encouraged to invite their students to participate in Interactive Judging.
4. Exhibitors must be present to participate in Interactive Judging. All other exhibits will be processed and judged in the traditional manner.
5. Interactive Judging is done using the Danish System of Judging described in the "Judging and Awards" section.
6. Only the shows listed above will be judged interactively. Exhibitors with exhibits in shows not listed above should refer to that show for instructions, or call us at (916) 263-2975.

## Entry Guidelines

### Entry Maximum:

Limited to three entries per person per class.

### Danish System of Judging

### Rules and Information:

1. All exhibits must be produced by the exhibitor.
2. Framed two-dimensional and three-dimensional exhibits must be securely wired for hanging or will not be displayed.
3. All unframed exhibits (matted or unmatted) may be hung utilizing small nails or staples in the corners of the mat or exhibit.
4. Recycled art is to consist of 50% or more recycled materials.
5. Digital art (computer art) should be entered in the Computer Technology Show.
6. This show is for exhibitors 9 years of age and older. For exhibitors under 9 years of age, see Primary Creative Exhibits.
7. The Sacramento County reserves the right to not display any art or photography that, in its' opinion is not suitable for family viewing.
